17. Declarations of Interest

There were no items listed on the agenda that resulted in any Member declarations.

18. Minutes of the Last Meeting of the Parish Council

The minutes of the last meeting of the Parish Council held on Wednesday 21st July 2004, having been circulated, were confirmed a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

19. Matters Arising on the Minutes

No further information had been received from Forest Enterprise on the subject of the closure of the car park at the top of Sulham Hill. It was agreed to let the matter rest.

An objection to the proposed increased charges for use of the Whitchurch Toll Bridge had been sent to the Road Charging Division of the Department of Transport, but had not yet been acknowledged.

20. District Council Report

Tim Metcalfe gave a brief report on District Council issues relevant to the local community.

The Draft Licensing Strategy was tabled. An Eastern Area Vision Task Group was to be formed with a view to examining the need for additional services in the eastern section of the West Berkshire District Council area.

An exchange of letters in regard to the possible use of land in Tidmarsh by travellers was noted. The District Council had pointed out that they did not have the power to stop travellers buying land.

An invitation was received to attend a meeting of the Neighbourhood Action Group at the Purley Parish Council offices on Wednesday 29th September, commencing at 6.30 p.m. Rod Taylor undertook to represent the Parish Council at the meeting.

22. Highways, Footpaths and Traffic Matters

Following agreement at the previous meeting, a letter had been written to Sally Hannon, the Executive Members for Highways and Transportation at West

Berkshire District Council, requesting that revised consideration be given to the request for a 30 mph speed restriction through the built up area of Sulham. A reply was still awaited.

An informal discussion considered the inadequacies of Tidmarsh Lane, and a parishioner agreed to attend the next meeting of the Eastern Area Forum to raise the subject.

23. Environmental Issues

It was agreed to support a request from the Friends of the Pang and Kennet Valleys for non financial support for an application for a grant to run a campaign to stimulate use of the splendid network of Rights of Way that exists in the Pang Valley and to encourage “Green Tourism”.

24. Crime and Disorder

Local issues were discussed.

25. Finance

Resolved that the following item be authorised for payment, such sum to be debited to the Parish Council account.
